

Seven Steps for

Riding the BUS

- 1** Determine the route you will need to take to get to your location. You can locate times and destinations in the City's Local Bus Schedule which is available in locations throughout the City or by visiting santa-clarita.com/transit.
- 2** Arrive at the bus stop five to ten minutes before the scheduled departure time.
- 3** As the bus approaches the bus stop, please stand near the bus stop and signal with your hand to let the driver know that you want to get on the bus. Board the bus through the front door.
- 4** Signs on the front of the bus, above the windshield, tell you the bus' route number and destinations. Read these signs to be sure you board the right bus. If you are not sure, ask the driver.
- 5** Have the exact cash, punch ticket, bus pass or transfer ready when you board the bus.
- 6** Once you board the bus, have a seat or go to the back of the bus to stand. Remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- 7** Stay alert for your destination. One block prior to your stop, signal the driver by pushing the black or yellow strip between the windows.
